



2018 MEMBERSHIPS TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Terms and Conditions:

Membership privileges are only extended to the individual for whom the membership was purchased and are not refundable, shared or transferable. No refund is provided if membership privileges are suspended due to Member misconduct. Identification may be requested at time of use. All benefits apply to the 2018 season only.

¹ Member does not pay a green fees and there is no limit to the number of rounds a member can play during the season. This does not apply to tournament or other fees associated with regular play or tournaments, eg. rental clubs or tournament fees.

² Member needs to ensure they have provided their member number in order to ensure discounts are provided at the time of purchase. Discounts do not apply to purchases made prior to becoming a Member. If discounts are not applied at the time of purchase, Member has 48 hours to submit receipt to a Manager to have discounts applied, after this time, discounts are forfeited.

³ Golf Canada members can track their game and establish an official Golf Canada Handicap Factor. Included in the membership is a subscription to Golf Canada magazine (delivered quarterly to your home) and access to the digital publication Global Golf Post weekly in your inbox. Members also receive preferred pricing access to Golf Canada's Rules of Golf Online Training and discounts and benefits on RBC Canada Open and Canadian Pacific Women's Open tickets, merchandise, insurance and other services.

⁴ Provides free range balls to the participant for the duration of the season. Range balls are only to be used at the practice facilities. Annual Range Privileges are for the use of the participant only and are not transferable. *Daily or weekly limits may apply but would not be less than one large bucket of balls per day.*

⁵ Social Dues are used to enhance the experience by sponsoring events and activities at Lone Wolf Golf Club.

⁶ Compliments of Kikinaw Energy Services, children/grandchildren of Members are eligible for a FREE Junior Membership. Limit of 2 per Member.

⁷ Spousal Rates would only be applicable if both persons are in the same age category. If not, then the higher rate must be paid for the primary membership and the spousal rate for that category would apply.

⁸ Lesson booking is coordinated with the Head Pro by contacting the Pro Shop. Booking is based on available lesson times and although effort will be made to provide flexibility in booking, it is up to the package holder to coordinate lesson times. Missed lessons without providing at least 4 hours notice will be deemed forfeited. Lessons are not transferable but can be semi-private (no more than 2 people total), please ensure that you inform the Head Pro in advance if there will be other individuals participating in the lesson. Understand that the lesson duration is one hour total, if there is more than one individual participating in the lesson, time spent with each individual will be reduced. Lessons not taken by September 30, 2018 are forfeited.
